Watercolour and drawing experienced is needed

Learn the techniques of stippling (pointilism) or line work with me on this two day workshop. Watercolour washes can look very effective over pen and ink and make wonderful sketchbook studies and artwork. Using fine liner pens we will work up a beautiful drawing and, then loosely colour it with watercolour washes. Bring your own subject or choose from my large collection.

Suggested subjects to bring: dried seedheads, wood, bark, pinecones, nuts, leaves, bulbs, other nature subjects, seaweed, shells, skulls, stones, oak galls etc.





Materials List

Please bring the following with you

- Magnani 1404 Portofino or Saunders Waterford High White - 9" x 11" sheet or larger.
- Uni-pin Fine Liner pen size 0.03 and/or 0.05 (I will have black pens for sale at £2.50 each.)
- Trace or cartridge for drawing.
- H Pencil, soft eraser (**not a putty rubber!**) and sharpener.
- Quality full-bodied pointed tip brushes.
- Two water jars.
- A white plate or flat palette.
- A little kitchen roll.
- Your usual watercolour paints - **not opaques!**
